How did Casey's BIG Things begin?

Jim Bolin got a BIG idea while on a family car trip to Colorado with his wife and two kids. His family brainstormed about opening a tea shop. But he wanted to do more to bolster his community. "I decided if we are going to do this, we would have to think outside of the box," he says. When he returned home, he began work on the 54-ft. tall wind chime, which took two years of planning and construction.

One could say that the wind chime started it all. Over the next five years, Jim and his team continued to add over-sized attractions to the community. Of those, eight of the attractions gained the World's Largest certifications including: the wind chime, golf tee, knitting needles, crochet hook, wooden shoes, pitchfork, mail box and rocking chair.

The pipes in the wind chime, wood for the rocking chair and raw materials for other giant items are reclaimed and repurposed raw materials from Bolin Enterprises' various businesses. All the big attractions were created in Casey, Illinois. This earned Jim Bolin a 2016 recognition from the Illinois Office of tourism as an official Illinois Maker.

As of September 28, 2019, Jim Bolin achieved 6 more World's Largest Certifications. They are a teeter-totter, key, golf club, barber's pole, swizzle spoon, and gavel. As noted on the map, the gavel is located at the Clark County Courthouse in Marshall, Illinois (20 miles East of Casey off I-70)
